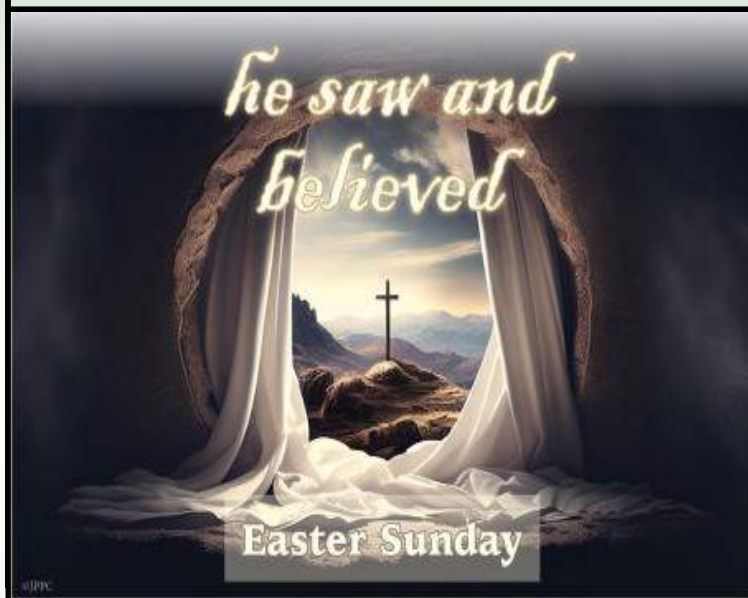

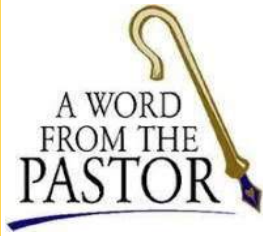

My Dear Parishioners,

The Lord is Risen, He is Risen Indeed, ALLELUIA!

On behalf of the clergy and staff of St. Patrick, I extend each of you a VERY HAPPY EASTER! Today is the Day of Salvation and we REJOICE in both the EMPTY TOMB and the APPEARANCES OF THE RISEN LORD!

I share with you here a reflection from Fr. John Hardon on the thought found deep in the Church – but not in the Scripture – of the Risen One’s appearance to Mary, His Mother! As Easter begins, let us pray God’s work to continue and to bring to great fulfillment his Plan for us, our families and our parish.

Our Lady, the First Witness

“The Mother was probably the first person to whom the risen Jesus appeared. Could not Mary’s absence from the group of women who went to the tomb at dawn (cf. Mk 16: 1; Mt 28: 1) indicate that she had already met Jesus?” (St. John Paul II)

It is not only a pious opinion that the Risen Savior first appeared to His Mother Mary on Easter Sunday. No less than six Doctors of the Church, including SS. Ambrose, Anselm and Albert the Great held that Our Lady was the first witness of the Resurrection. Pope Benedict XIV declared that this fact is “based on the tradition proclaimed by ancient architectural and liturgical monuments, starting from Jerusalem itself.”

Therefore it is not surprising that St. Ignatius of Loyola in his Spiritual Exercises simply assumes that Jesus “appeared in body and soul to His Blessed Mother” immediately after rising from the dead. In fact, Ignatius makes this Marian mystery the first of fourteen meditations on the risen life of Christ. It is also the key meditation which introduces the capstone of the Spiritual Exercises, the “Contemplation for Obtaining Divine Love.” We are to learn from Mary that “love ought to be found in deeds rather than words,” and that “love consists in mutual interchange on either side.”

The Resurrection Fulfills the Annunciation to Mary

Over the centuries, the Church’s masters of the spiritual life have explained why Christ opened His forty days on earth after the Resurrection by appearing to His Mother. It is because the Resurrection was the fulfillment of the Annunciation. At the Annunciation, Mary submitted her will by faith to the word of God. At the Resurrection, her faith was rewarded by actually seeing and speaking with her glorified Son.

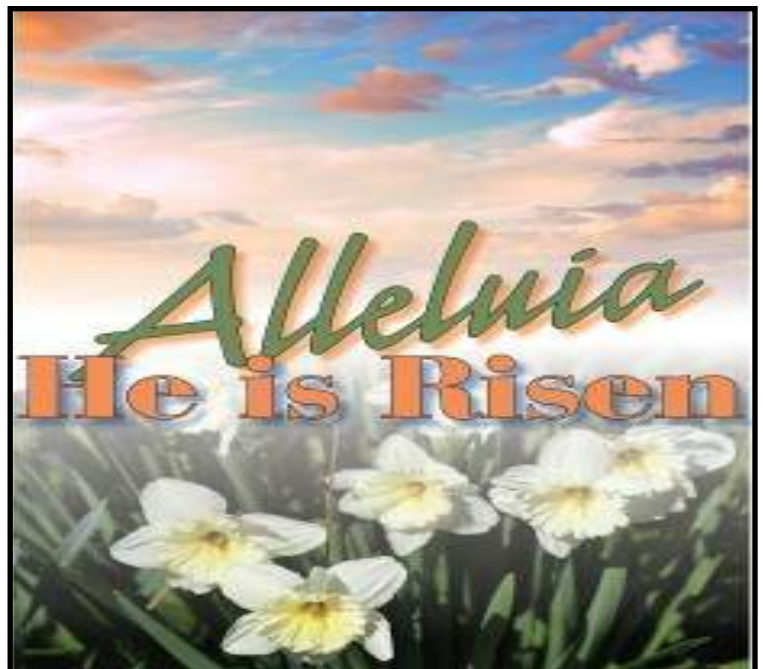

The Call to be a Minister of the Eucharist

These ministers, called Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, assist the Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (Bishops, Priests, and Deacons) in distributing Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament to all the faithful.

What does it mean to serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion at St. Patrick:

"At every Mass we pray these words: 'Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof...' yet at every Mass, when we receive the Eucharist, Jesus heals and forgives us in that one moment, and we are made worthy. As an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, I have the honor and privilege to share this gift with other Parishioners in the distribution of Holy Communion. Additionally, in bringing Communion to the homebound of our Parish I see in their faces, the gift of Jesus brought forth in the Eucharist." ~ Anonymous

both of which are where one may obtain the Jubilee Indulgence.*

Join St. Patrick Parish for a special journey to the National Shrine Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes, the oldest U.S. replica of the Lourdes shrine in France, and the National Shrine of Elizabeth Ann Seton, the awe-inspiring basilica where Mother Seton's remains are entombed. Both Shrines are places designated within the Archdiocese of Baltimore where one may obtain the Jubilee Indulgence.

We will **depart St. Patrick at 8:00 AM** and travel via deluxe motor coach to all destinations with an **estimated return home time of 6:00 PM**. Our first stop will be the National Shrine Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes and celebrate **Mass at 11:00 AM**. We will depart at 1:00 PM for the Shrine of Elizabeth Ann Seton. There will be time at each location for self-guided tours of the grounds. Flyer with full schedule can be found on the parish website.

Cost is \$50 per person (cash or check payable to St. Patrick Church) which includes transportation, donation to the Shrines, water and snacks for the bus. 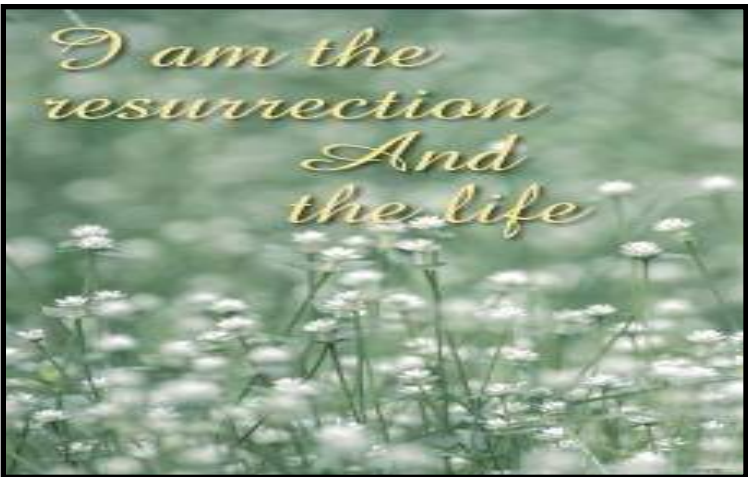
