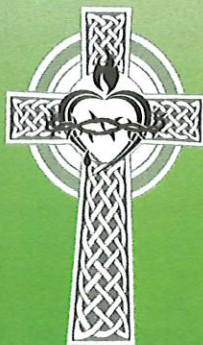

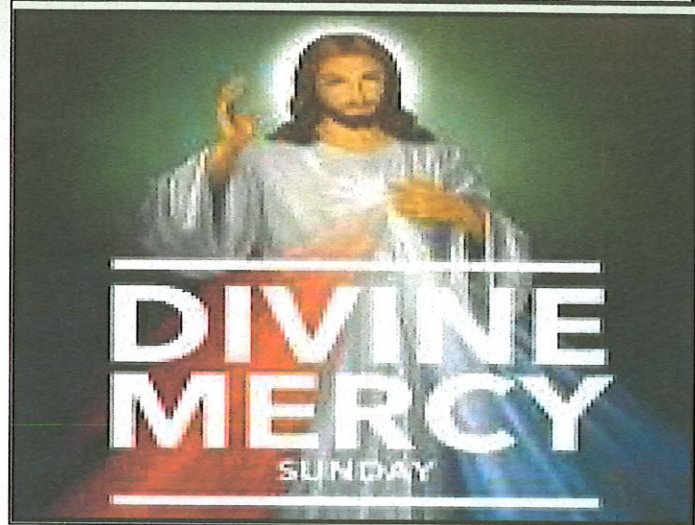

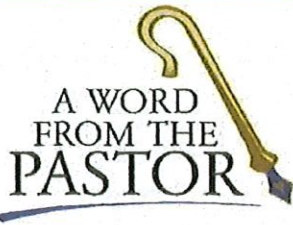

My Dear Parishioners,

Praised be Jesus Christ! On this Divine Mercy Sunday, I want to express my gratitude to ALL who made our Easter Weekend, Sacred Triduum and Holy Week so special. It was a tremendous celebration of God's Love and I am grateful to all – especially our musicians, choirs, church decorators, ushers, lectors and everyone – for their dedication and love for the parish.

Such celebrations do not just happen. They come from somewhere and they go somewhere. In the case of our parish community, our Lenten Preparation – thru small groups, bible study and prayer groups – all helped to contribute to the celebration of Easter. God planting a seed -- that seed being welcomed and cared for and that seed-bearing fruit in the lives of our parish. In the coming weeks, more parishioners will be fully initiated into the Church as we celebrate both First Holy Communion and Confirmation for our young people. In addition, there will be further baptisms, marriages, anointings and reconciliations. These Sacraments are moments of grace, encounters with the Risen Christ and they happen daily because of God's Great Goodness and individuals responding to grace. Such was the way of the early Church in these Easter Days. The stories of Divine Encounters with the Risen Lord from the Road to Emmaus to the Upper Room and beyond – all are made present in our own day and these Easter Days, we can welcome such encounters with God: Praying the Scriptures, Receiving the Eucharist and reaching out to one another with the tenderness of Christ.

The Beautiful thing is to remember where all this grace is going! It is all leading us closer to God! As we walk thru the month of April, be sure to Walk with the Risen One ... allow Him to lead, guide and direct you back to the Father ... in every aspect of your life! Allow Him to lead you into Life!

CULTURE OF LIFE CORNER

On the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy. It provides an important opportunity to share Christ's message of mercy, especially with those who suffer because of their participation in one or more abortions. By the age of 45, as many as 1 in 3 women have had an abortion, and a similar number of men and family members have been involved. Many feel that abortion is "the unforgivable sin." They need to hear that, through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, God forgives every sin of a repentant heart, even the sin of abortion. In fact, Jesus' message to St. Faustina is that the greater the sinner, the greater the right to His mercy.

DID YOU KNOW? APRIL IS ABORTION RECOVERY AWARENESS MONTH.

Are you or someone you love suffering from a traumatic pregnancy loss and experiencing: Depression, Anxiety and panic attacks; Intense grief, sadness, rage; Feelings of shame and guilt; Suicidal thinking and behavior; Drug or alcohol abuse; Problems maintaining intimate relationships; Eating disorders; Nightmares, flashbacks....**YOU CAN FIND HEALING!** Experience forgiveness and be freed from shame. Confidential, compassionate, non-judgmental help is available. You're not alone.

What is Project Rachel?

Project Rachel (<https://hopeafterabortion.com>) is the abortion healing ministry of the Catholic Church in the United States. It is a diocesan-based network of specially trained priests, religious, therapists, and laypersons who provide a team response of care for those suffering in the aftermath of abortion. In addition to referring for Sacramental Reconciliation, the ministry provides an integrated network of services, including pastoral counseling, spiritual direction, support groups, retreats, and referrals to licensed mental health professionals so that people affected by abortion do not have to carry their burden alone.

Walking Together Philly is a part of Project Rachel, a network of services in the Philadelphia area that provides support to people impacted by abortion. For more information visit <https://walkingtogetherphilly.org/>.

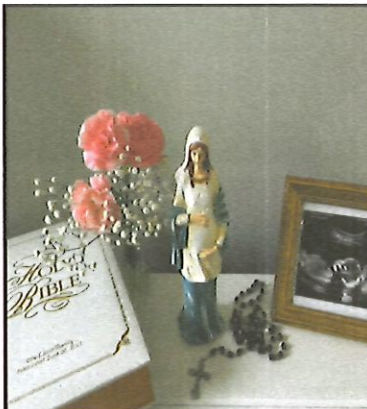

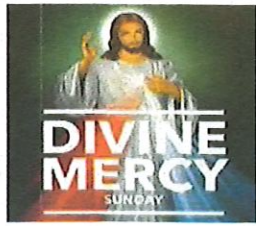
"We felt blessed to host the Expectant Madonna during Lent in the week leading up to Palm Sunday and

Serving children ages 3-6

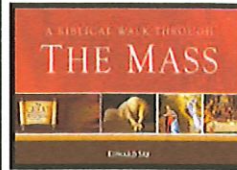
