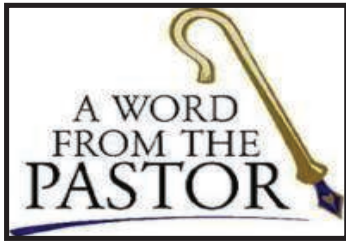

ST. PATRICK PILGRIMAGE

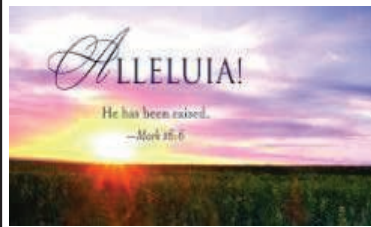


Friday, May 5, 2023

Join your St. Patrick friends for a day trip via deluxe motor coach first to the **National Center for Padre Pio** where we will learn more about the spirituality, work and mission of Saint Padre Pio. In addition to our guided tour, you will have time on your own to explore the beautiful grounds, museum, and the *Hell, Purgatory, and Paradise Exhibition* that is only on display through May. Thanks to the insight of 15-year-old Blessed Carlo Acutis and to the research completed by writer and journalist Nicola Gori, this exhibition presents 160 testimonies of Saints and Martyrs who have had visions of the Inferno (Hell), Purgatory, and Paradise. After our time at Padre Pio we will pay a visit to **Most Blessed Sacrament Church**, which is a neighbor to Padre Pio Centre and a historic church founded in 1741.

God's word as well as materials that coincide with each parable. For example, the Parable of the Pearl and the Hidden Treasure. The children listen to the short parable about the merchant searching for beautiful pearls. After listening to the story they are able to reenact the parable using manipulatives such as a merchant, pearl, basket, & table. They use tweezers to move small pearl like beads into different size shells. These materials were lovingly and thoughtfully created by fellow parish members according to the guidelines of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd.

Divine Mercy Sunday



Jesus, I Trust In You!

Each year, on the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy. In the 1930s, Jesus chose a humble Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private revelations concerning His Divine Mercy that were recorded in her *Diary*. St. Faustina's Diary records 14 occasions when Jesus requested that a Feast of Mercy be observed. On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy.

- Go to Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday.
- Go to Confession within 7 days of Divine Mercy Sunday.
- Trust in Jesus' Mercy and the graces that come from it.
- Be Merciful and Share God's Mercy with others.

- Venerate the Divine Mercy Image in your home.
- Participate in the Parish Eucharistic Holy Hour on Divine Mercy Sunday.
