

Praised be Jesus Christ! With the August's final two weeks upon us, school's return is as well. We see it in stores and will soon feel it as the school busses hit the road. The return to school for our seminarians will be very different this year, as St. Charles Seminary opens at its new location in Lower Gwynedd, PA . The seminary property on Wynnewood Road, i.e. "Overbrook" was sold five years ago to Main Line Health. And new buildings have been built in Lower Gwynedd. Prior to the relocation of the seminary, our parish acquired from the Wynnewood Road property, a variety of cement planters that sat in front of the lower side. While I'm not sure how long they sat there, I'm certain and very happy that we at St. Patrick's now have an historic piece of St. Charles Seminary. Mary Queen of Heaven & Earth

Mary's title as "Queen of Heaven and Earth" is a great scandal to many non-Catholic Christians. After all, the Bible doesn't mention anything about there being a queen in God's kingdom. All this royal attention Catholics give to Mary—whether it's singing "Hail, holy queen enthroned above" or portraying Mary in statues and paintings with a crown on her head—seems to many non-Catholics to detract from the royalty of Christ, who alone is King of Kings. Besides, how could Mary be a queen, since she is not the wife of the Jesus but only his mother?

One biblical theme sheds light on these questions and serves as a key for unlocking the mystery of Mary's queenship: the Old Testament tradition of the "queen mother" in the Davidic kingdom. In the monarchy of King David, as well as in other ancient kingdoms of the Near East, the mother of the ruling king held an important office in the royal court and played a key part in the process of dynastic succession. In fact, the king's mother ruled as queen, not his wife

The great pre-eminence of the king's mother may seem odd from our modern Western perspective, in which we think of a queen as being the wife of a king. However, recall that most ancient Near-Eastern kings practiced polygamy. King Solomon had seven hundred wives (1 Kgs. 11:3)—imagine the chaos in the royal court if all seven hundred were awarded the queenship! But since each king had only one mother, one can see the practical wisdom in bestowing the queenship upon her. And so Mary, the Mother of Christ the King, is indeed Queen! (For the rest of the story, google the above title and author.)


