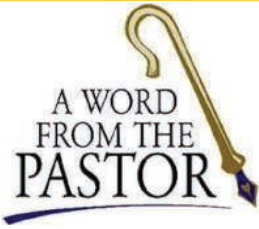

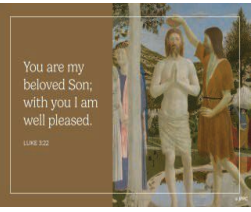

**Catechesis of the Good Shepherd**

**Serving children ages 3-6**



Catechesis of the  
**GOOD SHEPHERD**  
"Let the little children come"  
Matthew 19:14

Life in the atrium is steady, thoughtful, and peaceful. Children are given autonomy over what works they would like to do. These may include practical life, such as pouring water, spooning beans, sorting beads, which form the child's confidence and abilities. This practice transfers over into Liturgical life, and therefore a greater focus may be applied as one lifts their hearts up to see God's Word come alive in Liturgical presentations.

The children heard the story, The Birth of Jesus, from the Book of Luke 2:1-20. As we listened to the story the children were able to help tell the story by moving the figures. We focused on the shepherds who heard the angel say, "Do not be afraid! I proclaim to you the good news, which will bring great joy to all people." The shepherds went to see for themselves what the angel was talking about and found the baby and paid him homage. The children ended class by singing *Silent Night*.
