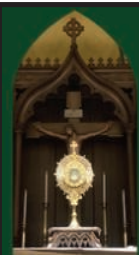

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a program founded on the teachings and philosophy of Maria Montessori for children ages of 3-6. The atrium, which

is central to the program, offers the place and time for the children to be who they are and hear God’s voice and work independently. Practical life centers in the atrium helps the child build a sense of purpose but intertwines with some of our liturgical work. Order, concentration, coordination and independence is consistently the direct aim of the activities in practical life.
