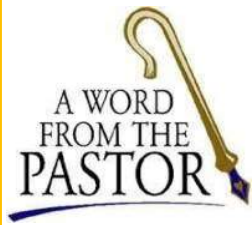

My Dear Parishioners,

Praise be Jesus Christ and Happy Pentecost!

Last week, I began some closing thoughts with the statement that ***Faith is not just taught, it's caught***. That statement leads us rightly to a Teacher or a "Pitcher", if you will...And that of course would be God, the Holy Spirit, who teaches and gifts us with Faith: The Holy Spirit enables us to acknowledge Jesus as Lord. The Holy Spirit is Lord and Giver of Life, itself! And that very Life of God poured out on the Apostles has been shared with us in Baptism, Confirmation and in all the Sacraments –making us sharers in the One Divine Life. As I've said many times over these years, without that Life of God, the Holy Spirit, we are just a Jesus' Club! But because of that Life, we are the very Body of Christ, receivers and witnesses of His Glory.

It was 50 years ago this year that St. Paul VI in his Apostolic Exhortation, ***Evangelii Nuntiandi*** wrote the following: ***"Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses" (41)***. I invite you to pause and read that again because 50 years later, it is still true.

At the minimum, witnesses are those who have seen something/someone. But in Scripture, "witness" is someone more. It refers to those who have come to know, even to love, something/someone. The Apostles were witnesses to Jesus Christ, not just seeing Him on the shore of Galilee but receiving His Mercy, Mission and Holy Spirit. And we are called to be the same: Witnesses -- of God's Faithful Love.

In my 10 years here, I have come to witness KSQ: that is I have come to see, know and love KSQ. And while that love never quite extended to the Mushroom, I no longer fear them. In fact, I have even eaten a mushroom or two in these past 10 years! But by far, the greatest reality that I have witnessed --- seen, known and loved --- here is the Christian Faith alive in God's People. In those who have come to faith, those who have grown/rediscovered the faith and been reconciled to the faith. This is the greatest gift that I have been privileged to witness. And it has strengthened my faith in ways that I did not have before.

And so, now, by God's Grace, I'm a stronger Witness of God's Love and Goodness and I get to bring that faith to others. And YOU...get to share that faith with a new pastor. This past week, I had the opportunity to welcome Fr. Tobin to St. Patrick, to give him a tour and introduce our staff to him. As I did so, I felt a tremendous pride, happiness and joy within me. For I know him to be a good priest and I know you to be good people, in whom faith has grown and will continue to grow as it is shared! This is the work of the Holy Spirit and on this Pentecost Sunday, we welcome that work anew. We are reminded that that work has a long way to go in us and even in KSQ. But going with God, is the only Way to go. Pray that for me and know that I pray that for you. May God Keep us on His Way.

What is a Lector?

This is a ministry of lay men and women who proclaim the readings from Sacred Scripture, with the exception of the Gospel, during the celebration of Mass. He or she may also announce the intentions for the Prayer of the Faithful when no deacon is present.

The desired assets for a Lector include:

- A registered parishioner who is fully initiated in the faith, in good standing and practicing the faith.

- A basic knowledge of the Bible, Lectionary for Mass, and the Liturgy of the Word.
- Strong oral proclamation skills.
- Willingness to serve at Mass 1-2x per month.

Those interested in serving as a Lector must be approved by the pastor and then receive proper training. A Lector Workbook will be provided for the preparation of the readings.

CULTURE OF LIFE CORNER

A Spiritual Bouquet to St. Joseph, Patron of Fathers

Fatherhood has its origins in God, who chose to reveal Himself to us as Our Father, sending his only Son for the sake of our salvation. Fathers therefore have a special role, "in revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God" (*Familiaris consortio* 25)

All men are called to the vocation of spiritual fatherhood; some are also called to live this out as fathers of biological, adopted, or foster children. While not a liturgical observance, Father's Day provides a wonderful opportunity to recall the essential role of fathers in the life of the family and in building a culture of life. It is also an opportunity to highlight the spiritual fatherhood of godparents, priests, deacons, uncles, and other men who often serve as fathers in important ways within extended family, parish communities, or individuals' lives. Indeed, the role of father "is of unique and irreplaceable importance" (*FC* 25). As such, Father's Day affords us the perfect moment to pray for all fathers including those facing an unexpected pregnancy, those struggling with infertility, those who have lost children, and those who have lost their own fathers.

St. Joseph, himself, was unexpectedly called to both practical and spiritual fatherhood, and amid very difficult circumstances. But despite all obstacles, Joseph was faithful. He welcomed life of the Christ Child, offering care and protection to Mary and Jesus. As a Church community, we need to encourage and support men to follow the example of St. Joseph and embrace their various roles as father.

A Spiritual Bouquet is individual prayers and acts of devotion offered up on someone's behalf. This Father's Day we invite you to lift up the many intentions laid on your heart to the intercession of St. Joseph, Patron of Fathers, while also honoring him, and giving him thanks for his fatherly love and care. Each individual act is like a spiritual flower that when gathered with other acts and prayers becomes a "bouquet."

When you come to Church next weekend, you will find intention cards in the pews. After all Masses, the Respect Life Ministry invites you to spend some time with St. Joseph - write down your prayer intentions and then place them in the basket that will be in front of the St. Joseph statue. We hope this spiritual bouquet provides an opportunity to pray for the intentions brought to your heart by Father's Day. This offering will remain throughout the month of June serving as a visual remembrance of the important vocation of fatherhood and the gift of life. Let us all cherish the gift of life we receive from our fathers and entrust all men to whom God gives life to the protection and care of St. Joseph.

PARISH REGISTRATION:
