My Dear Parishioners,

Praised Be Jesus Christ! Fifty-five years ago this year, a sledding accident on a hill in New York State changed the life of a young seminarian forever. His name was Bill Atkinson. Like many of our parishioners, Bill was a native of DELCO and his life changed the lives of countless people. Tonight, Sunday, Nov. 1, @5PM PBS will air his story: **Extraordinary: the Bill Atkinson Story**. It's worth watching it or recording.

If you were to rewind, one hundred years before Bill Atkinson, you would find the life of Michael McGivney. Michael was not from DELCO and he did not have a sledding accident. But his experience with immigrants as a young priest not only changed his life, but the lives of countless people. Tonight, Michael McGivney is now recognized as a citizen of heaven and was declared Blessed by the Church just yesterday. You can find his story on EWTN this weekend.

I share these two stories because as we turn forward into November, we remember all those who have gone before us. The Saints, those in purgatory and all are brothers and sisters who have died. They are countless but each is known and created by Almighty God. Each is an immortal soul. Each changed the world in big or small ways. And this weekend, as we turn our clocks backward, they remind us that there is no going back. Our lives move forward quite quickly. And those who have gone before us invite us to call to mind where we are going, to take stock of our lives: the gift of human life, the power of life and the eternal nature of it.

Here at St. Patrick's to assist in this regard, please note the following:

The Book of the Names of the Dead will once again be displayed in Church. Feel free to write the names of loved ones who have died especially this past year.

The Holy Souls Envelopes will be placed on the Altar throughout this month.

This Saturday, we will have a special 9 AM Mass for over 45 of our parishioners who died this past year. All are welcome.

Holy Water in plastic containers will be available in the front of Church to take home. This sacramental reminds us that in the waters of baptism we died with Christ.

In short, in November, we remember, we repent, we believe.

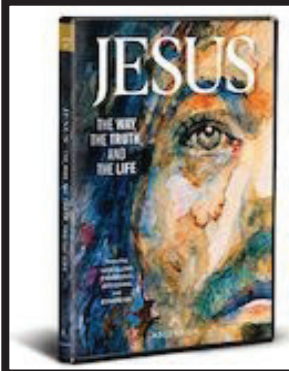

GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS IN THE GREEN PHASE

At all Masses, provide and wear a face covering. Exceptions are “children younger than 2 years old, anyone who has trouble breathing and anyone who is incapacitated or unable to remove the cloth face covering without assistance.” (CDC Guidelines) Please provide your own worship materials as missalettes will not be available. You are encouraged to take a Church Bulletin when entering Church as it will have the Hymns and Responsorial Psalm to follow the Celebration of Mass. Hand sanitizers will be available in the back of Church; it is recommended that you bring your own.

After exiting your car, please maintain social distancing as you walk on Church grounds. Before entering the Church, please put on your face covering and ensure that it covers both your nose and mouth. Ushers/Greeters will be present at all Masses who can answer any questions you may have regarding returning to Church and can assist you with any seating needs. Holy water fonts remain empty.

Pews will be marked off to allow for some measure of social distancing. Please space yourselves appropriately.

During Mass a collection will be taken up during the Offertory as usual with long-handled baskets. The procession with the Gifts during the Offertory is omitted. There will be no Sign of Peace and the Precious Blood will not be distributed.

Priests/Deacons may or may not wear a mask while distributing Communion. Sanitizer remains nearby if needed. The faithful are encouraged to receive the Body of Christ in the hand. For those wishing to receive on the tongue, the Priest/Deacon/EM will need to sanitize after each communion. Please be mindful of others. Those who desire to receive Communion, exit your pew towards the side aisle while maintaining social distancing in the Communion line. At the first pew, remove one side of your face covering. When the person in front of you has received Communion, proceed to Communion Minister to receive the Body of Christ. Reposition your mask and return to your pew via the center aisle while allowing for social distancing. At the conclusion of Mass, pews will exit through the center aisle one at a time from back to front. Please wait for the Usher’s guidance.
