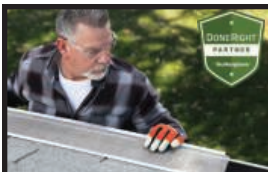
**PARISH REGISTRATION**

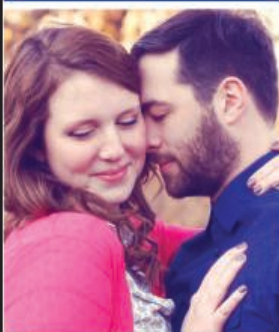
