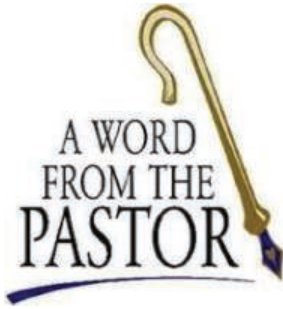

**PARISH REGISTRATION**

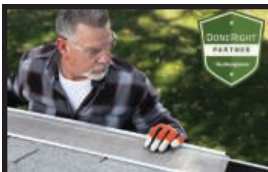

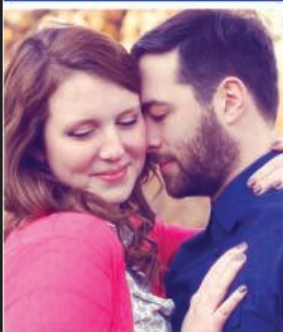
