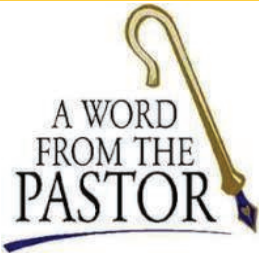

CHANGE FOR LIFE CAMPAIGN

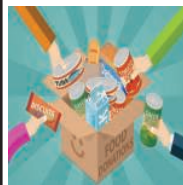
It's Respect Life Month! As such, St. Patrick's Knights of Columbus annual Change for Life Campaign is now underway. All donations will support Pro-Life causes.
