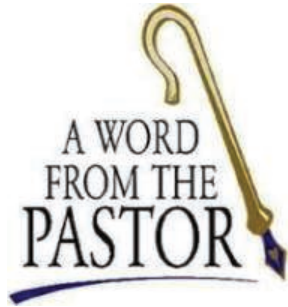

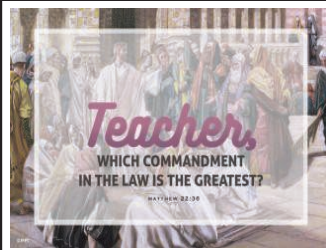
## CHANGE FOR LIFE CAMPAIGN

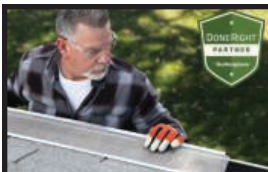
**PARISH REGISTRATION**
