

To St. Patrick Parishioners

From the Seminarian

Dear Parishioners,

Father Rogers has generously given me the opportunity to write this column to all of you while he is away. As I was praying on what to write about, one thing kept coming to mind, and that is trusting the Lord. The beginning of the school year at St. Charles Seminary has been filled with anticipation and excitement, but also a lot of anxiety and confusion. I would be lying to you if I said the year has started without any difficulties. Our excitement comes from the anticipation of meeting new peers and facing the many challenges presented together. We know the year will hold a lot of gifts, but also a lot of struggles as well. Encountering both the good and the difficult aspects of the year as brothers in arms will help us to grow in a deeper fraternity so that we can carry those healthy friendships out into the priesthood. These are the friendships which sustain priests and help them thrive, but they also have a deeper meaning. They are meant to symbolize and reflect our deep relationship and commitment to our Lord Jesus Christ.

As you are all aware, our Church is going through a tremendous period of trial at the moment. I phrase it this way because we know in Matthew 16:18, when Jesus says to Simon Peter, "On this rock, I will build my Church, and the gates of hell will not overcome it." The Church will not be overcome. Even though we trust in what the Lord has said, this does not make the trial any easier. There have been times over the past few weeks when I questioned why I wanted to pursue this life. Why should I give up having a family, and other good things for a life which seems to demand so much sacrifice while also appearing to give so little in return? Yet this is obviously faulty reasoning. The voice of the enemy can be very appealing at times...

After having these thoughts, I can't help but remember my experience this past summer at St. Pat's. Meeting all of you has been a tremendous gift and has brought me a lot of consolation. Many of you have reached out over the past few weeks to check in and see how I am doing; that meant a lot. The feelings of peace, joy, hope, and love remind me to look for God in the moment. It is a reminder as to why I am making this decision. I desire not only to serve you, but the entire Church in the way God desires for me. Feelings of hopelessness, despair, shame, guilt, and even scrupulosity do not come from the Lord. He asks us in those moments to trust in him, and we can only do that once we know *who* it is we are trusting. We are trusting our Brother and our Friend. We do not put our faith into fallen human beings, but into the Lord who has redeemed us. So I encourage all of you to continue fighting the good fight with courage and joy. Take the necessary steps to deepen your relationship with Jesus. We have many events and groups scheduled to meet throughout the fall season which will provide you with the means of doing just that. I hope my reflection allows you to reflect a little on your own life, so you can see how God is always by your side with a deeper clarity.


### ATTENTION ALL PARISHIONERS!


