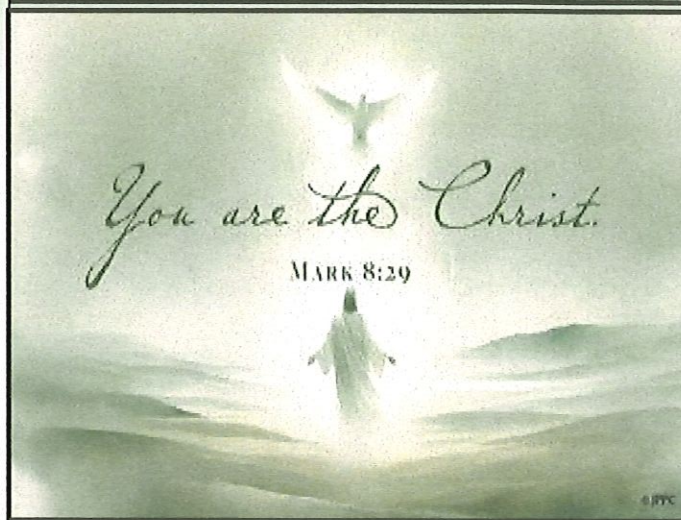

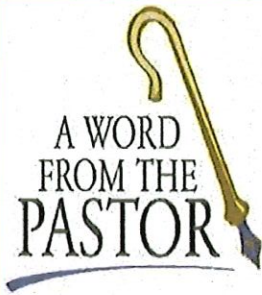

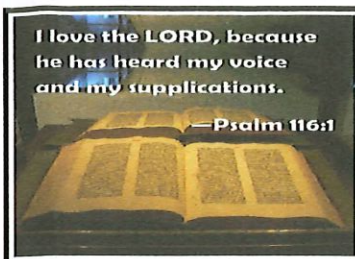

readings this week we will hear Jesus talk about the Great Commandment. Quietly reflect on who is Jesus to you.

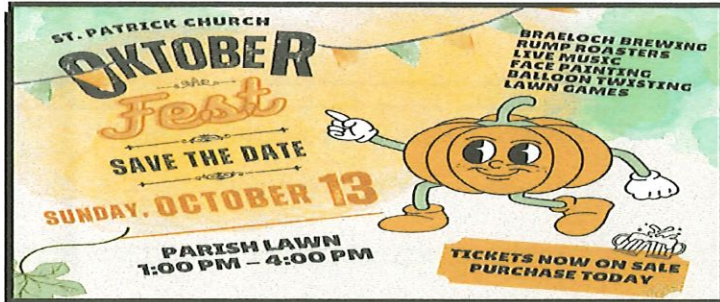
