There are **TWO FREE CHARTER BUSES** leaving from our area and both are open to all residents of Delaware or Chester County on a first come basis.

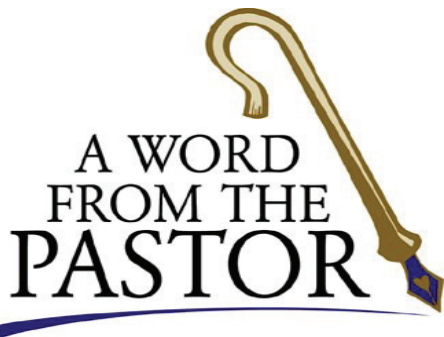

Combining resources, staff, and volunteer support, will allow us to offer a solid program for the youth of our parishes.

From our parish, Dan Pin, the Director of Youth and Young Adult for the Diocese of Wilmington, will serve as one of the leaders of this endeavor with the Youth Group. And Bill Dobbins will serve as CYO Athletic Director. Both will work with coordinators from the other parishes to provide for the program. And both will be looking for volunteers to assist with this good work! Be sure to learn more. Regional CYO Sports teams are forming now! And the youth ministry will begin on Sunday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at ABVM. Contact info for both items is in this bulletin.

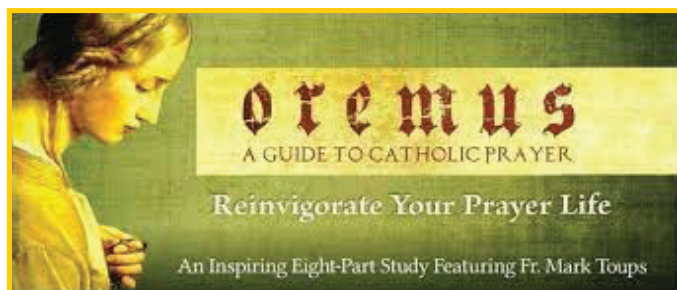
## BREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP
